

Guidelines: „LUXEMBOURG OPEN 2019“

The "LUXEMBOURG OPEN 2019", an international agility tournament, will be held on 09, 10 and 11 August 2019 in Niederkorn. The canine club "AMATEURS DU CHIEN DE RACE DIFFERDANGE" sets the rules concerning the procedure, as well as the organization of the "LUXEMBOURG OPEN 2019". On Friday morning there will be a tournament in grade 1. This will be advertised separately.

For the main tournament a maximum of 400 starter teams in the 3 standard classes SMALL, MEDIUM and LARGE will be accepted. Dogs have to be in grade 2 or 3 on the day of the event. Since there are no grades (open), all participants are equal. All dogs are allowed with and without a pedigree.

Every dog runs 2 jumping and 2 agility on the weekend. The three best dogs per run will be awarded with a prize. On Sunday there is a final.

The final will feature 40 large, 22 medium and 22 small dogs.

From each run, the 3 first Large as well as the 2 first Medium and the 2 first Small Dogs reach the final. If a dog qualifies twice for the finals over the rankings, this place will be occupied by a dog on the points ranking.

Each dog gets points in each run according to its placement, 1st place = 1 point, 2nd place = 2 points etc ...in case of an elimination he gets as many points as dogs are on the starting list. (200 dogs = 200 points) The best 3 runs are considered for each dog. The dogs with the fewest points get the remaining places for the final.

The final winner will obtain the "LUXEMBOURG OPEN 2019" trophy in his class. In addition, it is possible to enrol a team consisting of three dogs. This registration takes place on the spot. The team score is calculated from the points scoring of the 3 best runs of each dog in the team. The best team wins the "LUXEMBOURG OPEN 2019 IN TEAM" .. The registration fee for the individual classification for both days is € 30, for the team classification the starter fee is € 9 per team.

Any inconvenience caused during the competition will be clarified by the organizing club.
